

Wombenhood: exploring the field of menstruality Open-Ended Space Rules

Rules to be placed on the website and a link sent to the attendee alongside the event log in details.

- If you do not want to be recorded, please mute your mic and turn off your webcam, you can still communicate with the group via the chat.
- Wombenhood shall not tolerate any signs of discrimination, rude behaviour, insults or disrespect. Anyone who acts in this way shall be verbally warned and then banned from the Events if the behaviour does not stop.
- You can only access the events via filling in a <u>request form</u> and providing your email address, from here we will send you the necessary information so that you can access the group virtually via the Zoom platform.
- Wombenhood will use the following terminology, we advise you to do the following:
 - Secondary Party: Those who do not have wombs or do not experience Menstruality.
 - Menstruals: Those who experience, will experience and have experienced Menstruality and/ or have wombs.
- Wombenhood is open to all and we invite people who wish to learn more about the menstrual cycle and its many branches.
- You have to apply each time to attend an Open Space Event unless you are part of a Wombenhood Project and are classed as a Participant or a Collaborator.
- Wombenhood welcomes any questions or ideas, we do not believe that there is such a thing as a stupid question and we ourselves are constantly learning, we intend to learn from attendees as much as they can learn from us!
- Sensitive information: If you wish to disclose personal information, you do so at your own risk, Wombenhood is a welcoming environment but we must make you aware that the event shall be recorded and it is open to the public.
